Governor Schwarzenegger's executive order (EO S-3-05) would reduce GHG levels to 80% below 1990 levels by 2050. CARB wants to put California on track to meet its interim (2020) and long-term (2050) emissions reduction targets. How can we accomplish 80% below 1990 levels by 2050 if we permit projects that will last at least until 2050, but will reduce GHG only 29% below business as usual levels?
