## Reclamation holds meetings on 2-Gates Demonstration Project

Reclamation will hold public meetings to provide information on the proposed 2-Gates Fish Protection Demonstration Project in Fresno on Oct. 26, Discovery Bay on Oct. 27, and Stockton on Oct. 28. The meetings are being held in conjunction with the release of the Draft Environmental Assessment/Finding of No Significant Impact (EA/FONSI) by the Bureau of Reclamation. The proposed demonstration project is subject to environmental review under the National Environmental Policy Act. The EA/FONSI is available for public review and can be [accessed here](#).



The 2-Gates Fish Protection Demonstration Project was developed by the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California and the San Luis & Delta-Mendota Water Authority (SLDMWA) to test alternative ways of protecting delta smelt. This 5-year experiment is designed to modify flows in the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta to reduce entrainment of smelt and other sensitive aquatic species in Central Valley Project (CVP) and State Water Project (SWP) export pumps.
