OPC to Meet Sept. 10-11 in Half Moon Bay

Council to Hear Public Comment on Draft Strategy to Reduce Ocean Litter

WHAT: The Ocean Protection Council (OPC) will meet Sept. 10-11 in Half Moon Bay. Day one agenda items include the consideration of grants to conduct a Marine Life Management Act (MLMA) lessons learned study, create a collaborative fisheries research organization, continue implementation of the California Seafloor Mapping Program and develop a climate change adaptation model pilot study.

On day two, the OPC will convene a panel discussion about salmon issues in California and take public comment regarding the staff draft OPC Marine Debris Implementation Strategy that was released in July.
