The Natural Resources Agency (Agency) is pleased to announce the release of the guidelines and application for the California River Parkways (RP) grant program. Funding for this program is available through the Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control, River and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2006 – Proposition 84. <u>Available funding and timelines are contingent upon enactment of the FY 11/12 budget and subsequent budget decisions.</u>

Application period August 12 through October 14, 2011

(postmarked on or before October 14)

Anticipated project completion date May 1, 2016
