



Project Description: Goat Island Tidal Marsh Restoration

Project Type: Tidal Marsh

Restoration Targets: 80 acres tidal marsh. Adjacent Suisun Hill Restoration and Lower Spring Branch Creek Restoration adds additional land and habitat values.

Location: North Western Suisun Marsh at Rush Ranch

Landowner: Solano Land Trust

Funding: State Coastal Conservancy for land acquisitions and partial design. Funding unknown for completion of design and construction

Permitting: No permits completed. Needed: COE, RWQCB, BCDC,DFW, CESA, Solano County. Solano County Resource Management Department is lead CEQA Agency. Public Draft CEQA document pending.

Estimated Timeline: Dependent on financing for construction. 30%-60% design is completed.

Known Obstacles to Implementation: Funding to complete permitting, construction and perpetual management.
