



Sherman Island- Future Projects

Project Description: Additional future Sherman Island emergent wetland projects are planned. SH-2 Wetland North of Mayberry, SH-3 Wetland East of State Route 160, SH-4 Wetland Both Sides of SR 160. These project continue wetland restoration efforts on DWR owned lands on Sherman Island. These projects are conceptual, so timing is uncertain.

Type of Project: Palustrine emergent wetlands, upland and riparian habitats

Restoration Targets:

SH-2 Wetland North of Mayberry – 1,500 acres
SH-3 Wetland East of State Route 160 – 1,000 acres
SH-4 Wetland Both Sides of SR 160 – 1,400 acres

Location: Sherman Island


