The Pilot Project Working Group (PPWG) will present on our progress since the last PPWG meeting in May. Building on the efforts of the three-track approach we previously implemented, we completed a “Phase 2” on the Smith Creek subwatershed unit, acquiring data on potential areas of restoration and compiling cumulative effects methods. This approach includes remote sensing and modeling as well as existing planning documents to gather information about the state of the Campbell Creek Planning Watershed. Our efforts have been aquatic/riparian focused to this point and we will be seeking input on our existing methods as well as thoughts on how to broaden our focus to include terrestrial resources.
