



The California Natural Resources Agency would like to invite you to visit our new Timber Regulation and Forest Restoration Program training website. Visitors will have access to information used to develop timber harvesting permits such as Timber Harvesting Plans (THPs) and to gain insight into the agency permit review process. Our website mission is to centralize access to the review agencies' harvest permitting reference materials and to provide users with training opportunities that will promote efficiency, effectiveness, transparency, and education related to permit review processes. The website currently contains a document library, PowerPoint presentations, videos, past/current training events, and related material from a broad range of Review Team Agency resources.

All general users (public) should be able to access the site as a "guest" without registering for an account. Enter the following web address: <http://timbertraining.resources.ca.gov/login/index.php> and click "Log in as a guest" to enter the site and view content.

In the future, we plan to host online trainings and online courses that target certain groups. Most content will remain publicly available indefinitely and some may be limited to invitation only such as agency-specific trainings.
