





Playa Exposure 2003-2015



- 14,000 acres of exposed playa around the entire sea since 2003

SSMP Phase 1


- Phase 1 could treat up to 14,760 acres when fully implemented
- Addresses Short-Term goal of 9,000-12,000 acres of habitat creation and dust suppression



Decision-making Criteria

- Consistent with Governor's SS Task Force: 9-12,000 acres habitat creation and dust suppression
- Concentrate on areas where playa is emissive through 2021
- Close to agricultural return flow water supply
- Maximize synergy and compatibility with existing or planned infrastructure
- Maximize air quality and habitat benefits for dollars spent
- Minimize land use conflicts: compatible with renewable energy/agriculture
- Utilize existing environmental compliance documentation, authorizations and approvals
- Outside DSOD Jurisdictional Dam criteria


Phase 1 – New River West




Phase 1 – New River East
