Overview of Committee Facilitation



CONSENSUS & COLLABORATION PROGRAM (CCP)

College of Continuing Education

- Neutral, not-for-profit unit of California State University, Sacramento
- Formed in 1992
- Mission: Build the capacity of public agencies, stakeholder groups, and the public to use collaborative strategies to improve policy outcomes.

General Facilitation Approach

- ► Background review and initial engagement
- Interviews with Committee members (Stakeholder Assessment)
- ► Committee Charter and Workplan development
- ► Field visits / watershed tour
- Quarterly Committee meetings
- Subcommittee meetings (if warranted)

Background Review and Initial Engagement

Conduct meetings with Agency and State Assembly staff

Review past stakeholder engagement and water quality improvement efforts within the watershed

▶ Conduct initial Committee meeting

Blue Ribbon Committee Stakeholder Assessment

- Confidential interviews with all Committee members
- Provides "snapshot" of impacted stakeholders
- Prepare report outlining common themes and recommendations

Committee Charter and Workplan Development

- Prepare Draft Committee Charter:
 - Outlines communication protocols
 - ► Formalizes Committee structure, membership, and alternates
 - Describes recommendations/ decisions process by Committee
 - ▶ Validates Committee sunset clauses/procedures
- Prepare Draft Workplan:
 - ▶ Outlines the Committee process,
 - ► Includes deadlines and key deliverables

Field Visits to Key Clear Lake Watershed Locations

- Site visits conducted at next Committee meeting
- ▶ Identify areas of interest and implementation
- Prepare prioritized lists of challenges for investigation by the science team

Quarterly Committee Meetings and Annual Reports

- Quarterly Committee meetings.
 - ► Minimum of two meetings per year in Lake County
- ► All meetings subject to the Bagley-Keene Act
- ➤ Committee provides annual report to the Governor and Legislature, beginning on January 1, 2019

Subcommittee Meetings

- Subcommittees may be developed to:
 - ► Address Basin-specific issues
 - ► Conduct work in-between Committee Meetings
- Subcommittee need / membership / scope identified through Assessment and discussions with Committee
- Subcommittee meetings subject to the Bagley-Keene Act
