What additional information do you need to discuss projects?

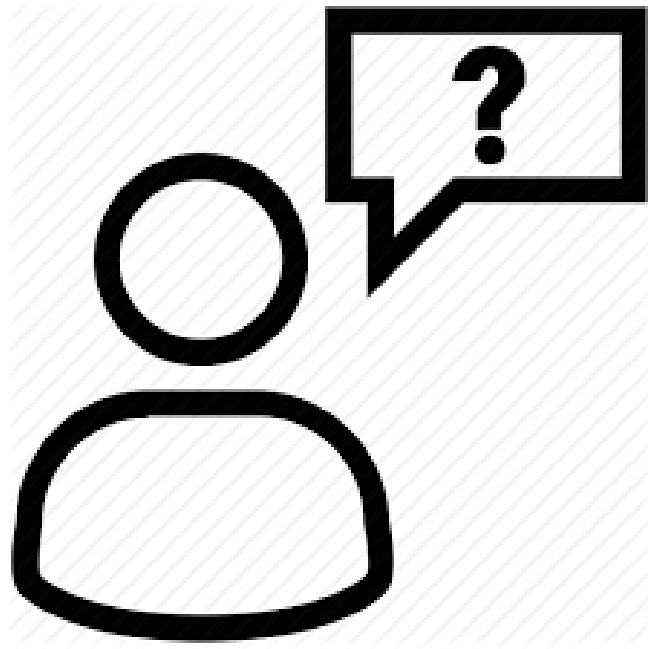
Alternative Funding Sources
