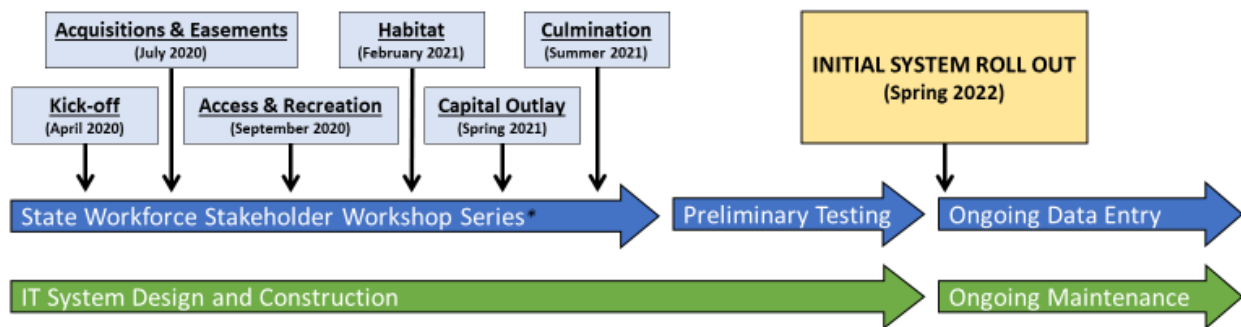


Resources Agency Project Tracking and Reporting (RAPTR) System

- Fact Sheet -

The California Natural Resources Agency (CNRA) is developing a **centralized** project management and reporting system called RAPTR to **aggregate project data** and **track the long term success of CNRA-managed funding sources and projects**. The RAPTR system will be a resource for all grantees and State employees managing State-funded projects relating to the stewardship of California's natural, cultural, and historical resources.

RAPTR will include...

- A grant application portal
- Project management and invoicing features
- Document storage
- Performance monitoring resources
- Analytical opportunities

RAPTR will help to...

- Consolidate data entry across multiple reporting systems
- Streamline State-funded grant management processes
- Track and evaluate project and program success

A State IT team is constructing the system with input from a range of program managers and staff across the CNRA and other partnering agencies. The RAPTR system is anticipated to roll out starting in **Spring 2022**.
