Project Description: The El Segundo Energy Center (ESEC) is a 560-megawatt (MW), natural gas-fired, combined-cycled and simple cycle gas turbine electric generating facility that was certified by the California Energy Commission (CEC) on February 5, 2005, and began operation on August 1, 2013. The facility is located at 301 Vista Del Mar Blvd. in the city of El Segundo.

Modification Description: The approved Petition to Amend the Final Commission Decision is to modify the ESEC Air Quality Conditions of Certification to uprate Units 5 and 7 gas turbines. The maximum output of the facility would increase from 573 MW to 580 MW.

On June 25, 2021, the CEC approved the above-described project change pursuant to a regulatory program certified by the California Secretary for Natural Resources under section 21080.5 of the California Public Resources Code, finding that:

- The proposed modification(s) would not change the findings in the Final Commission Decision pursuant to Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1748;
- There would be no new or additional unmitigated, significant environmental impacts associated with the proposed modification; and
- The facility would remain in compliance with all applicable laws, ordinances, regulations, and standards.
