Project Description: The Campbell Power Plant is a 158-megawatt, combined-cycle, natural gas facility. The project was certified by the California Energy Commission (CEC) in November 1994 and began commercial operation in October 1997.

Modification Description: The approved Petition to Amend the Commission Final Decision to modify the Campbell Power Plant to increase the cooling tower volatile organic compounds emission rate contained in conditions of certification and the corresponding air quality permit conditions from the Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District (SMAQMD) to allow the project to resume operations using recycled water, in compliance with all applicable laws, ordinances, regulations and standards.

On March 9, 2022, the CEC approved the above-described project change pursuant to a regulatory program certified by the California Secretary for Natural Resources under section 21080.5 of the California Public Resources Code, finding that:

- The petition meets all the filing criteria of Title 20, section 1769(a), of the California Code of Regulations, concerning post-certification project modifications;
- The project will remain in compliance with all applicable laws, ordinances, regulations, and standards, subject to the provisions of Public Resources Code, section 25525;
- The modified project would not have a significant impact on the environment;
- None of the criteria in California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 1748(b) applies to this project amendment; and
- This project change does not meet any of the criteria set forth in Public Resources Code section 21166 that would trigger preparation of a subsequent or supplemental environmental document.
