Please remove item 8 Water Infrastructure Improvement for the Nation (WIIN) determination from the California Water Commission (CWC) 18 Dec 2019 meeting agenda it is premature and inappropriate as I have not received any public records of WIIN correspondence I requested in item 1 below. Attached is a letter I received from Senator Feinstein that reads WIIN is not being considered in any current legislation. This letter was included in my 26 Feb 2019 to the CWC which is also attached but was removed from the CWC website by CWC staff because they did not like my Scary Tunnel, Oroville, Los Vaqueros video public comment.

I think it is reckless and misguided for the CWC to continue to approve and fund off stream reservoirs they are algal bloom incubators and will only get worse with climate change. Algae cannot grow without sunlight in underground storage the CWC needs to change the trajectory of its approval and funding from surface water storage to underground storage.

2-Approved Contra Costa Water District (CCWD) Los Vaqueros early funding agreement invoices from 16 Mar 2019 to present Aug 2019, I have invoice #1 that was approved 15 Mar 2019.

3-The following deliverables in the CCWD Los Vaqueros early funding agreement:

Proforma cost model, Final Environmental Impact Report (EIR), Final Feasibility Study

4-Photos, damage assessment and inspection reports sent to CWC and Division of Safety

of Dams (DSOD) after the 16 July 2019 earthquake whose epicenter was directly below

Los Vaqueros reservoir. I am particularly interested in the effect of the earthquake on

cracks documented in the Oct 2018 DSOD annual inspection report and that DSOD and

CWC are tracking this issue. The early funding agreement requires reporting anything that
