RESOLUTION TO FIND SOUTH-NORTH INTERTIE PIPELINE PHASE II PROJECT  
CONSISTENT WITH PROPOSITION 1

WHEREAS, Congress passed the Water Infrastructure Improvements for the Nation Act (WIIN Act) on December 9, 2016 and President Obama signed it on December 16, 2016;

WHEREAS, section 4007(f) of the WIIN Act requires the California Water Commission (Commission) to determine that all State-led storage projects seeking funding from the WIIN Act are consistent with the California Water Quality, Supply, and Infrastructure Improvement Act (Proposition 1);

WHEREAS, on November 20, 2019, the Antelope Valley-East Kern Water Agency presented information about the South-North Intertie Pipeline Phase II Project ("Project") in Los Angeles County to the Commission at a publicly noticed, regularly scheduled Commission meeting;


WHEREAS, the Commission discussed the project from the dais and opened the item for public comment;

WHEREAS, based on the information presented and discussion of the Commission, the Commission voted to determine the South-North Intertie Pipeline Phase II Project is consistent with Proposition 1.

Has determined the Project is consistent with the California Water Quality, Supply, and Infrastructure Improvement Act, based on the materials presented at the meeting of the Commission on November 20, 2019.
