East Bay Regional Park District	Coyote Hills Restoration and Public Access Project	\$800,000.00	Project to construct 1.3 miles of new trail, wildlife observation platforms, and interpretive displays. Project is adjacent to the San Francisco Bay Trail to the east and the Alameda Creek Trail to the north.
Fortuna, City of	Riverwalk Recreation Area Land Acquisition	\$620,194.00	Project to acquire portion of parcel along the Eel River bordering existing trail.
National City, City of	Paradise Creek Pedestrian and Bicycle Pathway Phase 1	\$914,300.00	Project to acquire commercial property adjacent to Paradise Creek and convert to river parkway.
Santa Barbara, City of	Arroyo Burro Creek Restoration at Palermo Drive - Property Acquisition	\$500,000.00	Project to acquire 5.3 acres in fee for development rights, restoration along Arroyo Burro Creek and passive recreation. Property will be rezoned from residential development to parks/open space.
Santa Cruz, County of	Soquel Creek Linear Parkway-Completion	\$1,499,699.00	Project to complete the Soquel Creek Parkway with extension of trail (connecting schools and neighborhoods to each other and to park; riparian restoration.
Santa Rosa, City of	Lower Colgan Creek Restoration Phase 2	\$494,804.00	Project to restore portions of Colgan Creek.
Truckee Donner Land Trust	Downtown Truckee Riverfront Park	\$1,000,000.00	Project to acquire 100 acres in fee along the Truckee river. Eventual connection to the Truckee River Legacy Trail.
Trust for Public Land	Ventura River Floodplain Acquisition Project	\$1,000,000.00	Project to acquire 28 acres of floodplain north of City of Ventura. Currently zoned commercial; bisected by stretch of the Ventura River Trail.
Yucaipa, City of	North Bench River Parkways Groundwater and Habitat Enhancement Project	\$1,152,000.00	Project to restore/protect open space, develop detention basins with passive recreation (trails and observation areas).
